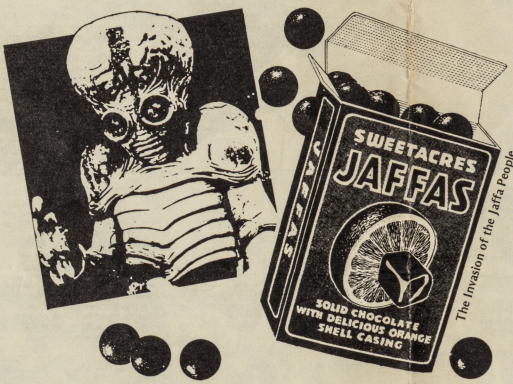

## 4ZZZ AT THE MILES

Triple Zed is planning to extend its entertainment services into the area of visual stimulation as there seems to be a group of avid cinema devotees in Brisbane, who are pinning for more adventurous cinema 'gems'. We have been exploring all the cinema available to us in town and have come up with the Centre Cinema in Edward St. and the Rialto in West End. These cinemas offer different possibilities, and we will probably use both for different occasions. The Centre has an extremely comfortable theatre but can only fit 170 people. The Rialto can fit 700 people although it has a less central location. In the near future you can look forward to the screening of such R&R extravaganzas as the *CLASH OF THE TITANS*, *THE HARDER THEY COME*, *THE GREAT R&R SWINDLE*, and some oldies such as *CLASH OF THE TITANS*, *THE WILD ONE* and *REBEL WITHOUT A CAUSE*. Triple Zed's technicians Dave Aberden and Graham Newton have promised quality sound to fit the visual impact of the films.

Other planned goodies are THE THREE STOOGES shorts, the original *SUPERMAN* and *BATMAN* episodes, the *MARX BROS.* sci-fi clangers, blood guts and horror, and political epics.

Our thoughts also go towards fest-



ivals of FILM NOIR and GODDARD, the utmost exploitation of Australian films from the Sydney Film-makers co-op, and of course local Brisbane 'underground' talent, featuring Triple Zed's most famous filmmaker STEVE STOCKWELL with the premiere of his screen epic HITS.

Screenings are planned to fit into the

average listeners lifestyle, mainly on weeknights that don't clash with Triple Zed's R&R gigs, and on weeknights after midnight!
